 - ? What is being scored? Wildfire risk is a growing concern for insurance companies.
 - All risks are considered within an area (see side); 30 year history of wildfire + wildfire rating;
 - Firewise communication with insurance representative is important, however classification is based on computer scores (AZ-WRAP: needs to be updated more often)
 - Recommendation: contact insurance agents with information about Firewise-USA + FAC; and ask them to communicate to their underwriters about "improved wildfire safety"
 - What can HOA do? Encourage Homeowners to talk to their agent ... educate them about Firewise (provide short story of prevention)
 - o Current application is suppression; Future needs to reflect prevention (which is Firewise)
 - Ask Broker: access to broader spectrum of insurances
